Winemaker Notes: This is a balanced, food-friendly wine with aromas of rich, dark cherry and currants, hints of vanilla and a light floral/meaty spice. Supple tannins and balanced acidity provide the framework for luscious dark red fruit and berry flavors and a hint of chocolate on the long, lingering finish.
