



## 2011 Walla Walla Valley Cabernet Franc

**Winemaker Notes:** This full-bodied red sports amazingly rich aromas of cedar, currant, red pepper, and pencil shavings. These aromas spill over into flavors of dark cherries and boysenberries that ride big, but gentle tannins into a smooth cedary finish.
