Winemaker Notes: This medium-bodied red starts out with rich dark cherry aromas accentuated by hints of vanilla, cedar, and pencil lead. The smooth coating mouth features alternating flavors of bing cherry and chocolate covered strawberries. Enjoy this wine by itself or as the perfect complement for Thanksgiving dinner. Also pairs well with grilled fare.
