Winemaker Notes: This full-bodied red is sourced exclusively from our certified sustainable estate vineyards in the Walla Walla Valley (LIVE, VINEA, IOBC, and Salmon Safe). This wine's inky black color foreshadows the dark earthy aromas and flavors that await you in the glass. Complex aromas of graphite, black tea, cedar, and molasses lead into a huge mouthful of blackberry tar, cedar, and wet granite. Not for the faint of heart.
