



2008 Walla Walla Valley Syrah

Winemaker Notes: Our three estate vineyards are certified sustainable by LIVE, VINEA, IOBC, and Salmon Safe. Our 2008 Syrah pulls from all three of these estate vineyards and is a testament to the quality of Syrah grapes available from distinct growing regions in the Valley. This full-bodied red has spice notes on the nose of white pepper, and allspice that lead into smoked meat, and aromas of lavender, and black plum. Expect a big mouthful of black fruit that is rich, intense, and smooth as it works its way to a lengthy cedar finish.
